This guide will help you understand how to attend the PTC conference using the AccelEvents platform that we have chosen for this year’s Virtual Event.

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Welcome to Chief Seattle Council's Program Training Conference 2020!

This year we are choosing to run our conference fully Virtual! This decision will allow as many people to attend and receive training as possible while still ensuring the safety of our Scouting families!

For 2020, we have changed our platform for ticketing. In years past we have utilized the Chief Seattle DoubleKnot system which you may be more familiar with when registering for past council or district events (and may already have much of your information saved on). We are using a Virtual Conference system called Accevents which will manage registration, payments, and the actual events.

This will mean changes to how you purchase tickets, register for classes, and attend sessions. Our hope is to provide you with all the information you need to ensure a successful conference!

VIRTUAL Program & Training Conference

The Program & Training Conference continues to STILL be an area-wide, one stop training opportunity for leaders and parents from the entire council. Accevents is a flexible format that supports the Program & Training Conference in its presentations and operations.

Purchasing Tickets

To purchase tickets, you can start at the Chief Seattle PTC conference page. You can also directly access the ticket ordering page below:

When purchasing tickets, you will complete these steps:

1. Step 1 – Select your Ticket Types and quantity.
2. Step 2 – Ticket Buyer (Who is buying the tickets, not who is attending).
3. Step 3 – Ticket Holder (Attendee) – For each Attendee, who is attending. **If this is the same as the Purchaser, there is a drop-down at the top of the attendee page to copy the information from the previous page.**

There is additional information to be filled out as well regarding Council, District, Unit, Age, etc.

You may purchase tickets for others and not yourself if you desire, simply fill out the attendee information with the other persons information.

4. Step 4 – Checkout – This is where we will collect Payment.

Please note: The Purchaser is who will be able to register for sessions if you are registering for multiple attendees!

Registering for Sessions

In past years, you had to register for your session at the time of ticket purchase. This year the system allows much more flexibility. We are allowing more attendees in each session being a Virtual event. As a result, you no longer need to pre-register for a session at the time you purchase your tickets. However, you will still need to register for the sessions prior to allow for attendance to be taken. Please make sure to do that before the morning of the event!



Logging In

During your purchasing process you were presented with a place to create a password on the Ticker Buyer page of the purchase tickets system. You will use the e-mail address and a password provided at the time of purchase to log into the Virtual Event.

You can log in by clicking the Login at the top of the page, or “Login to Register” next to a session.

Searching and Filtering Choices

When searching, there are a few buttons to help you out.

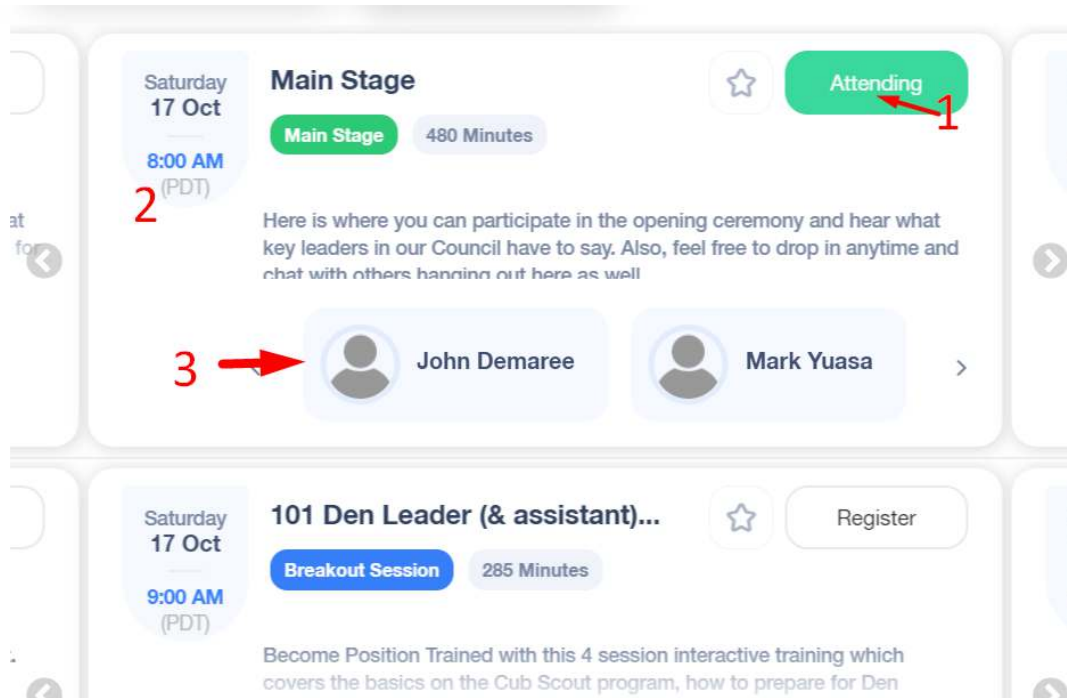
- All Sessions – This allows you to see everything! Great for scanning. Also see the brochure at <https://www.seattlebsa.org/ptc-documents/1674-2020-brochure/file>
- Speakers – If you know who is presenting a class, this is the easy way to find it!
- My Sessions – Once you register for a session, this is an easy way to see what exactly you have registered for.
- My Interests – When you are deciding what to attend, marking your Interests can help you quickly come back and find that class. Tip: If you are stuck between two classes, register for the one that you want, and then mark the other one as Interested. If the one you attend is not working out, quickly find your other interested course to change over!
- Search Sessions – This is a freeform text box. If you know the session #, such as “101 – Den Leader (& assistant) Training”, you can type in the number, in this case, “101” to quickly find the class or “Den Leader” to search for that name.
- Tracks & Tags – We have helped organize the meetings like the brochure, to help you find the right class for the topics you are interested in. Just click on this button to see a more organized list.

Depending on your browser (i.e., mobile or Desktop), you will see a list of classes.

On Desktop – You will see a list of start times and sessions within those start times.

On Mobile – You will see a long list of sessions. Be sure to use the filters to help find what you are looking for!

Here is an example of the screen



Using the picture above:

- Area #1 – This is your Register or Attending button. This button will be White when you are looking for sessions, and Green when Attending.
- Area 2 – This is the date/time of the session, the name of it, how long, and a description.
- Area 3 – These are the PRESENTERS for the session.

Registering

Once you have found the session that you would like to attend, click the **Register** button for the session. The button will change Green when you are registered. In the very rare circumstance that the session is full and accepts a waitlist, you will have an option to be put onto the waitlist.

To un-register for a class, click the Attending button and it will change back to white.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to system limitations, you are able to register for multiple sessions at the same time. Please choose only ONE, and mark the other session as INTERESTED.

Viewing your Registered Classes

Once you have registered for all your sessions, you can pull up your agenda by going to the Agenda page again and selecting “My Sessions” button.

During the Event

Entering the Event

During the registration phase, you will likely have seen the Agenda and other event elements. When the event begins, you will be visiting the “Hub”. From the PTC event page, you will see a “Enter Event” in place of “Buy Tickets” button. You must be logged in to see this button. It should prompt you to log in if you have not.

Please note that the button will only appear 30 minutes before PTC begins.

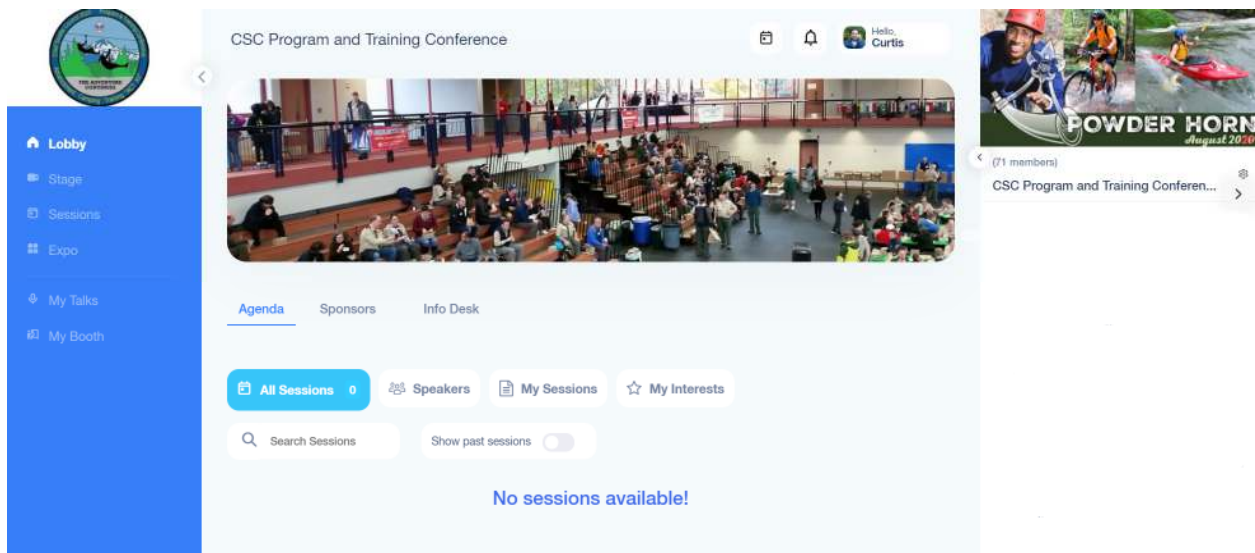

Below is an example screenshot of where you will see the “Enter Event” button when it appears for the conference on the registration site.



Event Hub

The “Hub” is the central place that we will be starting the event. If you have been to a past PTC, this page is like the gymnasium at the North Seattle College. This page is where the opening Main Stage will be as well.



On the left side, you will see 4 Links: Lobby, Stage, Sessions, and Expo.

For those who are presenters or exhibitors, you will see additional links on the left. As an attendee, you will not have the “My Talks” and “My Booth” links. This is for speakers and exhibitors.

Lobby – This is the central hub, kind of like the Gymnasium. This is where you can check out the agenda for the day, our Sponsors for the event, and an Info Desk which we will be posting guides such as this one.

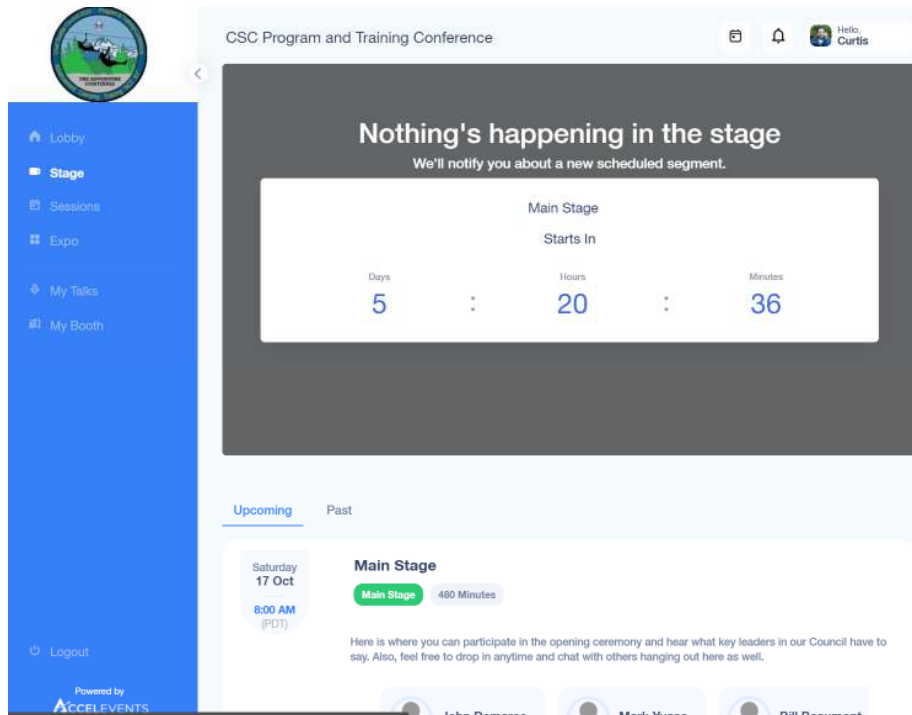
Stage – This is the MAIN STAGE only. This is where we will meet for Opening Ceremony

Sessions – This is where you will access your sessions/classes/breakouts.

Expo – Please come visit each of our Exhibitors! They all have great Scouting related things to share!

Going to the Opening Ceremony

Like all PTC events, we will be hosting the Opening Ceremony on the “Main Stage”. On the left-hand navigation is a link to Stage. Please come join us! See the Attending a Session for what the Main Stage and all Sessions will look like.

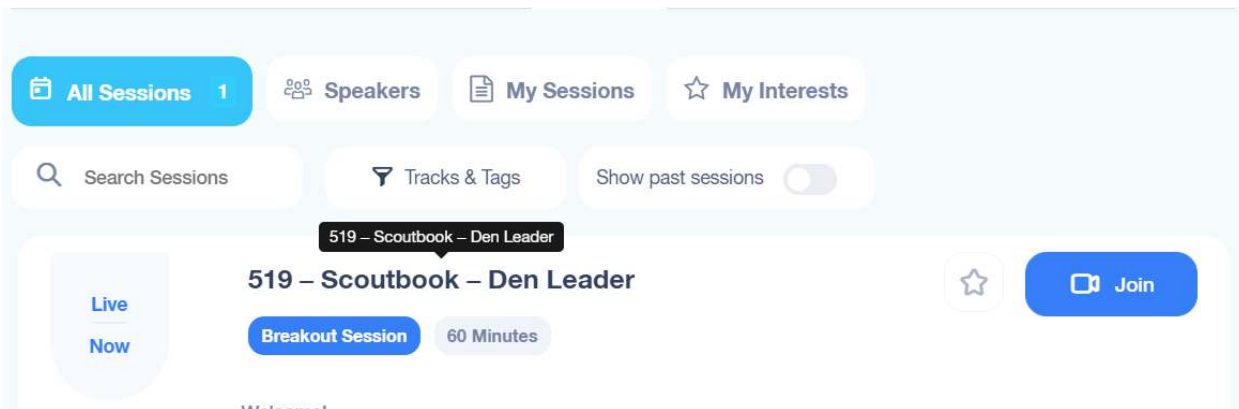


When the Opening Ceremony begins, the gray box will be changed to the online video presentation automatically. You can enter/leave the stage area at any time.

Attending a Session

To attend a session, click on the Sessions on the left-hand side of the page. Just like on the Registration Page, you will see the same ability to filter sessions and different ways to view them.

The difference is that the Register button will now be replaced with a “Join” button. This will allow you to join the session.

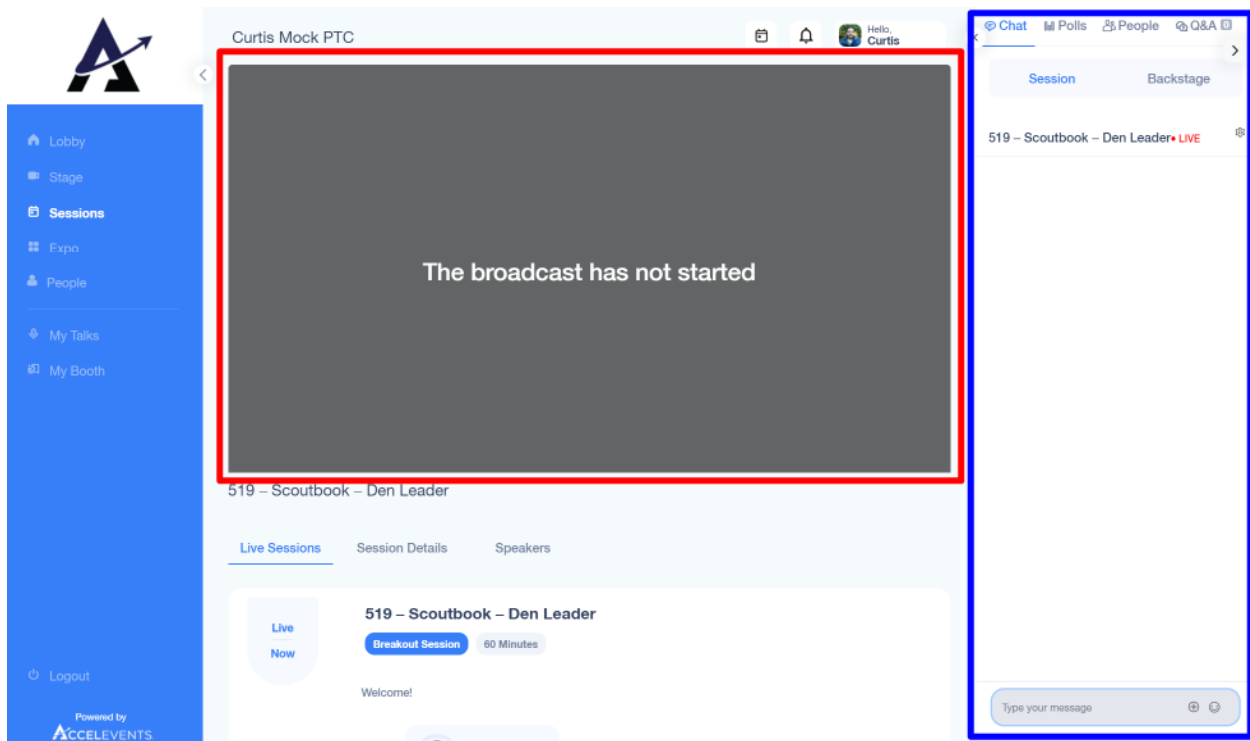


We will be having two different types of sessions.

Presentation – Presentations will be generally for classes with a single topic. Presentations will have limited interactive communication. A Chat room will be available for asking questions, as will a Q&A area, and Polls conducted by the presenter.

Interactive – This will normally allow for video chat with all participants, breakout rooms, etc. These will be used for more intense training guided by an instructor.

When joining a session, you will see a screen like this:



- The Red area is where the video share will be.
- The Blue area is where the Chat, Polls, and Q&A will be.

Presentation Sessions (AcceEvents)

During a presentation session, a video will appear with either a live view of the presenter(s), a presentation deck (Power Point), or both. As an attendee you will not share Video or Voice. This is a one-way presentation.

To ask questions, use the Chat feature.

Interactive Sessions (Zoom)

In an interactive Zoom session, the same screen will appear. The difference is that the Red box will now be the Zoom call. Many people are familiar with Zoom and how it operates.

One thing to note is that on the Zoom call, a button will appear with diagonal arrows allowing you to make the presentation full screen. This will allow you to see more.

In a Zoom Session, you will be able to share Video and Voice.

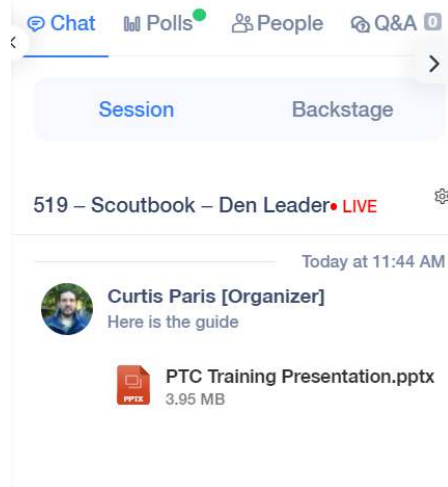

Using Chat

In the Blue Box is the Chat tab, we have said that this is a Chat window. Simply type in your message and hit Enter to send.

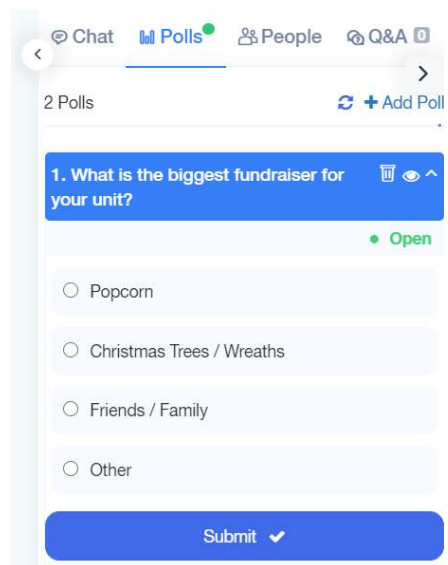
Downloading Handouts

During the session, an instructor may provide handouts (attachments). Examples might include the recipe guide, the presentation deck, pamphlets, etc. Click on the file to download it.



Answering Polls

In the Blue Box area is a “Polls” tab. When a new Poll is given by the instructor, a green circle will appear next to the “Polls” tab on the right side of your screen. Click on the Polls tab, select your answer, and click Submit! It’s that easy!



Getting Training Credit

For sessions that will be giving BSA Training Credit, you must attend the entire session. At the start, middle and end of the session the instructor will utilize polls to actively check for participation (some interactive sessions will use roll-call).

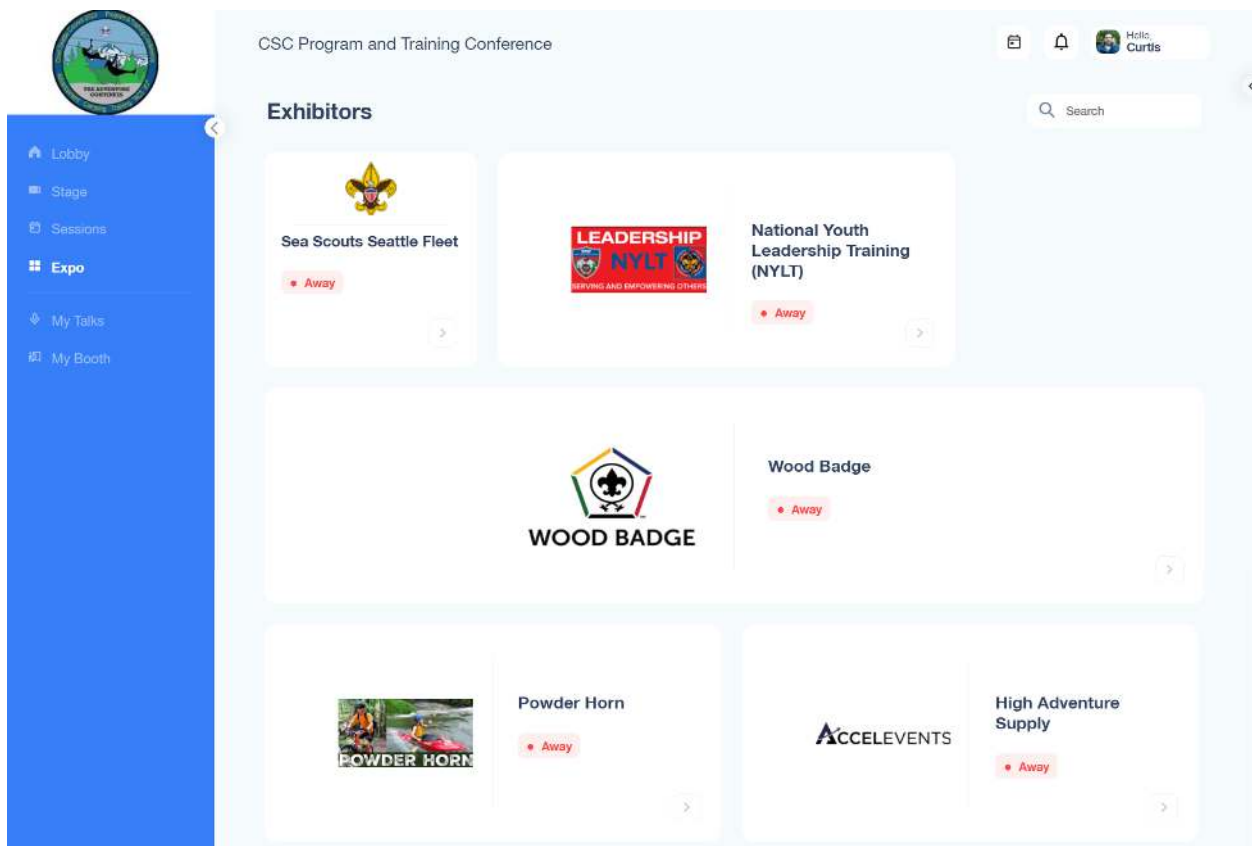
You **MUST** answer the required polls to receive credit. These polls allow us to inform BSA that you were at the class for the entire time.

IMPORTANT: If you do not answer the polls, you may not be given credit for the course!

Expo Hall

Before you end for the day, be sure to visit all our exhibitors. Just click “Expo” on the left side.

When you click into an Exhibitor you will see a list.



When clicking into an Exhibitor, you will see their page. They may provide a Live Meeting to join and talk with the presenter, you can watch a pre-recorded video, see any offering that they may have, etc. Each Expo page will be customized by the presenter. Look for their posted hours in case they are not there all day. And you can always send them a message or request a meeting. Come and check them out!
