About the Lions Pilot Program

- The Lion rank is not new... it was the highest rank in Cubs from 1930-1967.
- The new Lion program is for Kindergarten age and is the lowest rank in Cub Scouts.
- The new Lion program was first piloted in Northern Star Council in St Paul, MN (also MA and NY) in the early 2010's (exact time not known).
- It was expanded to National Pilot status last March 2016.
