



Description: Through the generosity of Scouting supporters, ten scholarships will be presented to high school juniors or seniors or college students in their freshman year at the Eagle Banquet on Wednesday, May 21, 2025. **Applications are due Friday, May 2, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. PST.**

- (5) \$3,000 Wings of Eagles Scholarships
- (2) \$3,000 Major General Howard & Bessie McGee Eagle Scout Scholarships
- (1) \$3,000 Bruce Kennedy Scholarship
- (1) \$3,000 Robert J. Capps Scoutmaster Scholarship
- (1) \$3,000 West Niver Scholarship

All Scholarships are to be used for tuition at an accredited college or trade school. Funds will be sent directly to the school. For Eagle Scouts in 7th through 10th grades, please wait until your junior or senior year to apply for a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on a combination of academic performance, community service, and need. **Procedure: The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must complete the electronic application personally.**

- Applications are due May 2, 2025 by 5:00 p.m. PST.
- One recommendation letter and one transcript must be attached (see requirement #5).
- Fill out the application form completely and submit it via email. Also attach both a) recommendation letter b) transcript with the form and email it to cscdevelopmentdept@seattlebsa.org and copy a parent or guardian.

Requirements:

All applicants must:

- 1. Have achieved the Eagle Scout rank.
- 2. Submit applications online by **Friday**, **May 2, 2025**.
- 3. Be a high school junior or senior, or in freshman year of college.
- Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.

- Be advised that applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant. Those selected will be notified before the banquet. Written notification will not be sent to applicants except those selected.
- No paper submissions will be accepted.

- 5. Attach one signed recommendation letter from a volunteer or Scout leader who knows the applicant personally. This letter should attest to the general character of the applicant. **Endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc. will not be considered.**
- 6. Attach a copy of the applicant's high school transcript.
