Summer Camp Staff

Camp Parsons and Camp Pigott host Boy Scout resident camp programs, and Camp Edward hosts Cub Scout resident camp programs. Minimum ages for most positions are 16, 18, and 21 years of age depending on position and level of responsibility. Staff are generally required to serve out the entire summer season on staff (usually 6-10 weeks).

Weekend Camps

Camp Edward weekend Cub Scout camps during spring, summer or fall such as Parent/Pal, Cub Day at Camp and Family Camp. Minimum ages for most positions are 16, 18, and 21 years of age depending on position and level of responsibility.

High Adventure Trek Staff

Camp Parsons is the Chief Seattle Council's High Adventure Base. High adventure staff members specialize in leading expeditions - hiking, canoeing, and/or kayaking. They are part of the summer camp staff and may occasionally have other responsibilities in camp. Minimum ages are 18 or 21 years of age depending on the level of responsibility.

Winter Camp

Camp Sheppard hosts weekend programs for Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts from December through March each year. Paid and volunteer staffing opportunities are available. Minimum ages for most positions are 16, 18, and 21 years of age depending on position and level of responsibility.

Counselor in Training / Volunteer Summer Camp Staff (unpaid position)

Scouts between the ages of 14 and 17 have the opportunity to be trained as summer camp staff through the Counselor in Training program, volunteering one or more weeks to experience what it is like to work at a Boy Scout summer camp. Opportunities for individuals over the age of 18 to volunteer for all or part of the summer season are also available (including, but not limited to, serving as a commissioner, medic/physician, assistant ranger or chaplain).
