

Snoquera Falls

BSA Camp Sheppard Hike 1.6-miles to falls; 3.8-mile loop, 900ft

- Good late spring/early summer hike as falls are meltdriven
- Harry Sheppard purchased in 1947
- CCC Camp in 1930s, dubbed Snoquera Camp Snoqualmie + ERA.
- 1890s a stopping point on wagon road route to Starbo Mine





Tipsoo Lake

Mt. Rainier Wilderness Hike0.4 miles around lake; 3.5-mile loop, 500ft

- · High summer hike; will be crowded
- Road over Chinook Pass 1931
- Restroom is one of twin facilities built by CCC in 1933/34
- Tipsu is Chinook Jargon for "grassy lake"
- Host to a ski area from 1945 to 1949



Mima Mounds

Natural Area Preserve Hike 3.3-miles of total trail, 2 loops, Oft

- Excellent spring hike, camas blankets the ground
- National Natural Landmark 1966
- No consensus on origin of mounds, but pocket gophers currently favored.
- American Indians managed the prairie with fires for generations to harvest camas
- Wilkes Expedition 1841


Gold Creek Pond

ADA Accessible Hike 1.1-mile loop, Oft

- Easy for any hiker, small picnic area, more to explore
- Did not exist before 1960
- Gravel mine for construction of I-90
- 1980s saw conversion to current park/hike
