You will check in between 8:00AM and 9:30AM. Check-In will look quite a bit different than it has in the past, and we ask for your patience as we work to keep everyone safe and healthy.

- We ask that you and your passengers remain in or at your vehicle until met by staff and escorted to the check-in table.
- At your vehicle, please be prepared to answer a brief health questionnaire and have your temperature taken.
- Unfortunately, we cannot admit anyone with the following:
 - a temperature of 100.4F or greater
 - has experienced symptoms of, or tested positive for, COVID-19
 - has been in close contact with anyone who has experienced symptoms of or tested positive
 - in the past 14 days.
- Please bring a face covering to wear. Their use is required indoors and out, vaccinated or not.

Camp Details

- The day's program will begin at 9:50 AM with an opening ceremony in our large playing field where we can ensure proper social distancing and safety and will end at 4:00PM.
- Activities include Halloween-themed crafts, shooting sports and more. Activities are ageappropriate for 6-10 year-olds, however 5 year-olds may participate in all but BB gun shooting.
- Your admission includes lunch. Siblings and friends under age 5 not participating in the
 program may purchase lunch at \$8 each or attend free without lunch included. (Specialized
 food options for vegetarian, allergies, etc. are not offered. If required, please plan to bring
 your own.)
- Wear your costume, and please bring a face covering to wear! Dress appropriately for the weather. Scout uniform is nice but not required.
- The BSA Medical Form Parts A & B is required for Scouts unaccompanied by their parent.

If you're in a large group, staff will make every effort to keep your group together, but it may need to be split between stations as limitations on group sizes have been mandated by health department officials. We appreciate your understanding and patience in working with us on this.

Cleanings will take place in between group program and lunch rotations.
