Please join us in honoring ***Pillar of Puget Sound*** recipient **Sally Jewell**, in recognition of her leadership as **US Secretary of the Interior** 2013 - 2017, as **CEO of REI** 2005 - 2013, and more than 40 years in business in our region.

As the 51<sup>st</sup> US Secretary of the Interior, Sally advocated for balanced protection of public lands and waters, leveraged science to shape a landscape-level understanding of our resources, nurtured a respectful nation-to-nation relationship with Native American tribes, and engaged youth in opportunities to experience and care for their natural world.

Sally grew up in the great Pacific Northwest, enjoying the bounty of the natural world through science-oriented summer camping trips, sailing, Girl Scouts, Camp Fire, and The Mountaineers. She deeply appreciates the importance of engaging children in nature, building their confidence, self-reliance, and appreciation for the world around them. These experiences shaped her commitment to youth engagement throughout her career.

Sally's volunteer service in environmental, educational, and business organizations has given her an appreciation of the inner workings of our democracy and civil society. She serves on the boards of Costco, Symetra, Green Diamond Resources, The Nature Conservancy, plus multiple advisory councils focused on solutions to climate change, effective government, Native youth empowerment, and shaping a future that is equitable, economically viable, and environmentally sustainable for all.
